

ACCESSIBLE PRESCRIPTION DRUG LABELING FACT SHEET



Accessible Prescription Labels are special labels provided by pharmacists to patients who have a visual or print impairment.

A person who requests accessible labels receives their medications with a regular printed label, called a 'legal' label, and a specialty label, called an 'auxiliary' label, which could include large print, talking and/or Braille labels, depending on the needs of the patient.

Accessible labels are provided at no additional charge.

Large Print Labels

A label printed in high-contrast large font is attached to the prescription container. A 2D bar code offers access via mobile phone applications.

Talking Labels

A small electronic tag is attached to the container. The tag contains the same data found on the printed label. A prescription reader reads the label information out loud.

Braille Labels

A clear adhesive Braille overlay is placed over the printed label for quick identification. Braille labels are often used in conjunction with talking labels.

To request at a participating pharmacy:

- 1) Customers can choose an already participating pharmacy and make their request. The pharmacy will help get prescriptions transferred to the new location and affix the labels on the next refill of medications. We are adding new participating pharmacies daily so in order to find the most up-to-date listing you can call us at 800-890-1180 or go to our website at www.envisionamerica.com/ourpharmacies
- 2) The pharmacy will notify En-Vision America that the patient needs a reader sent to them and will be participating in the program. En-Vision America will contact the patient to verify their address, shipping options and go over the terms and conditions of the free loan program.
- 3) If a customer does not hear from us within a few days of requesting at their pharmacy, they should contact En-Vision America to check on status of their pharmacy sending the request to us.

Retail Pharmacies- *Call En-Vision America at 800-890-1180 for help with location set up.*

- **Walmart/Sam's Club:** (ScripTalk) Pharmacists can search the WIRE for "ScripTalk" for information. Each Walmart location orders the necessary equipment from Walmart corporate to create and affix the labels at the local retail location.
- **Winn-Dixie/ BI-LO/ Harveys** (ScripTalk, ScripView, Braille) Patients can request pharmacist contact Pathstone Health Manager of Clinical Services for information on how to begin providing accessible labels. ScriptAbility labels will be created at a central location and sent to the local pharmacy and affixed to the prescription.
- **Costco** (ScripTalk) Patients can request the pharmacist call the Costco Help Desk for more information on how to provide ScripTalk labels. ScripTalk labels will be created at a central location and sent to the local pharmacy and affixed to the prescription.
